Introduction

- 1. At the meeting of the Museums Committee in March 2010 a plan to mount one commemorative plaque per year was agreed.
- 2. The nominations still to be carried out include Sidney Little in 2011, Alan Turing in 2012 and Edward Lear in 2013.
- 3. The owner of Baston Lodge has made an application for listed building consent to mount a plaque to Alan Turing on her property. She has undertaken to pay for the entire cost, including an unveiling ceremony. Details have not yet been decided.
- 4. A request has been received from Michael Howard to commemorate Alf Cobb, Robert Tressell's co-campaigner in the Hastings Social Democratic Federation. Alf Cobb is buried in Hastings Cemetery and lived at 7 Brook Street.
