# **Purpose of Report**

**Reasons for Recommendations** 

### Introduction

- 1. The Museum has received a request from the Director of the National Maritime Museum for the loan of the JMW Turner watercolour 'Hastings: Fishmarket on the Sands'.
- 2. This is for a major exhibition to be developed by the National Maritime Museum in association with Tate Britain entitled 'Turner and the Art of the Sea'. The exhibition will run from November 2013 to March 2014, and is intended to be a landmark reappraisal of the subject. Other lenders include national institutions in Britain, Europe and the United States.
- 3. The Hastings work would be displayed with a group of finished, large-scale watercolours that were exhibited at the Royal Academy. It is hoped that a related oil painting 'Fishmarket on the Sands, Hastings' painted in 1810, will be on loan from the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art in Kansas.
- 4. The National Maritime Museum will ensure that packing, transportation, security and environmental control are provided to the highest standards, and will meet the cost of transportation and associated courier costs.
