Reasons for Recommendations

Introduction

- 1. A fourth meeting was held with interested groups on 10 January 2012. Action points from the previous meeting were reviewed and the Curator provided an update on the latest developments.
- 2. The Stanhope Press has now been moved to HMAG and the base has been repaired. The first printing workshop will take place on 3 March with an introduction to woodcuts for adults.
- 3. The Ground Floor has been redisplayed and now contains cases covering Prehistory to Medieval, with new graphic panels.
- 4. Work on the Upper Floor redisplays will take place in March to accommodate exhibitions change at HMAG. Unblocking a window will be investigated although environmental and light level readings will be taken.
- 5. The group discussed marketing and income generation opportunities. A second marketing consultant has been contacted, and an appointment is awaited.
- 6. The Head of Amenities and Leisure presented a paper providing a preliminary assessment of the possibility of transferring all or part of the museums service to a charitable trust. The group agreed in the short term to concentrate on efficiencies to improve visitor attendance and income.
