Purpose of Report

Reasons for Recommendations



Introduction

- 1. A preliminary meeting was held on 8 October of a working group set up to consider a proposal to develop Heritage Trails for Hastings and St Leonards. The proposal is to produce a simple double-sided illustrated A4 leaflet for each trail. This would then be available free either electronically or as a hard copy.
- 2. Possible subjects to be covered include Maritime, Gardens, Women, Blue Plaques, Churches and Built Environment. The trails would lead people on a walk around the town and point out places of interest.
- 3. The Museum has been co-ordinating Blue Plaques since 1997. The original budget of £500 allowed for 2-3 plaques per year. Since 2008 one a year has been produced as capacity and resources were reduced. There is now no specific budget for the plaques which are funded from the Museum's publicity budget.
- 4. Plaques have now been erected for most of the subjects chosen at the original and subsequent meetings. It is suggested that from 2013 the amount currently used for blue plaques, around £200-300 per year, be used towards the Heritage Trails project.
