The application for a premises licence is being applied for on exactly the same conditions (bar the exception of the additional conditions accepted by the applicant).2. The existing licence has been in place on the same conditions since it was granted two years and operated without any concerns.

In addition, the Applicant has agreed to a contact line to be made available for the public once the licence is in operation.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Sussex Police were consulted on the application and there was no concerns raised inline with the objections.4. The grant of the licence would not undermine the licensing objectives.
