Purpose of Report

To inform the Audit Committee of recent audit findings during the follow up audit of Housing Benefit and Council Tax Benefit

Recommendation(s)

1. That the Audit Committee note the report.

Reasons for Recommendations

To monitor the degree of implementation of accepted recommendations.

Background

Follow up audit of Housing Benefit and Council Tax Benefit

 An audit of Housing Benefit and Council Tax Benefit was concluded in March 2008 and the follow up planned during 2008/09. 11 accepted recommendations were made for improvement and agreed by management. Of the 11 recommendations made, 1 was high priority, 8 were medium priority and the remaining 2 were low priority. Audit focuses on high priority recommendations made during follow up review.

Overall Audit Assessment

2. A: Good. Adequate controls are in place and work effectively. There are no significant audit concerns. No further high or medium recommendations have been made.

Key Findings

- 3. 9 of the 11 recommendations made had been implemented and 2 no longer applied. The 2 that no longer applied related to cheques but now all payments for this area are made by BACS transfer. Audit considers this implementation rate to be good.
- 4. The one high priority recommendation made was that a risk assessment of the Local Housing Allowance be undertaken. This was done at the time and now other risks have been assessed in the Corporate Risk Management system (GRACE).
