# Purpose of Report

#### **Reasons for Recommendations**

The overall Use of Resources score is 3 - performing well.



## Background

- 1. The Use of Resources Assessment Framework for 2009 is much changed from previous years and is a much tougher test.
- 2. The Assessment is now based on three themes of:-

Managing Finances Governing the Business Managing Resources

- 3. Within these themes the Key Lines of Enquiry (KLOEs) are different from previous years and the Assessment more outcome focused than the previous regime.
- 4. The Assessment is undertaken by our External Auditors, PKF Ltd, and Robert Grant will be at your meeting to give a presentation of their findings.
- 5. Attached, as Appendix A, is a draft of information provisionally supplied by PKF Ltd. As Members will see, of the eight KLOE's we are assessed against, we have scored 3 (performing well) in seven and scored 2 (performing adequately) in the other.
- 6. Our overall Use of Resources score is 3 performing well and we should be pleased with that.
