- 1.1 The Charity Commission are finalising the draft Scheme for the Foreshore Trust, which will appoint the first trustees. A vacancy has arisen on the Foreshore Trust upon the resignation from the Council of Councillor McDonnell.
- 1.2 The Council makes two nominations to the Foreshore Trust with the representatives being nominated by the two largest political groups on the Council. The retired nominee is the Labour Group appointment and therefore the Leader of the Labour Group has been asked to submit a nomination. The nomination will be reported at the meeting.
