**41(E) APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE DRIVER'S LICENCE – DR677**

The Head of Environment and Highways reported on an application for renewal of a Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Vehicle Driver's Licence following the Board's refusal to renew the licence on 27 February 2001 due to the accumulation of excess penalty points and a false declaration on the renewal application.

Two of the convictions had now expired and the applicant now only had three penalty points on his DVLA driving licence.

The applicant was in attendance and explained the reasons for his application.

**42(E) REGISTERED DOOR SUPERVISOR- RDS008 – CRIMINAL CONVICTION**

Following a criminal conviction for common assault, the Head of Environment and Highways, after consultation with Sussex Police, had revoked the Door Supervisor's Registration for Registered Door Supervisor 008 on 18 October 2002.

The Door Supervisor wished to appeal and the matter had been brought to the Board for a decision on whether or not to uphold the revocation of the Registration.

The Door Supervisor was in attendance and explained the circumstances surrounding his conviction. He produced a letter confirming his absence from the country following his conviction and a character reference from his current employer.

**RESOLVED – (By 4 votes to 1) that the revocation of the Registration for Registered Door Supervisor RDS008 be overturned in view of his valid reason for not reporting the conviction and his previous six year unblemished record.**
