- There will be a register on the premises recording any refusals of the sale of alcohol.
- Staff will receive training on their responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003.
- Written records will be kept of staff training.
- An incident register will be maintained on the premises.
- Any registers/recordings will be made available to an appropriately licensed officer upon reasonable request.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- Management and staff will remain vigilant of all activities on the premises.

- There will be a minimum of one security staff during the peak times above, on duty no later than 21.00hrs.
- A register will be maintained detailing security staff working on the premises.
- The premises will maintain a 3 CCTV camera system hard drive (HDD) system, recordings from which will be available to appropriate officers upon reasonable request.
- There will be no new admission to the premises after 02.00am

c) Public safety

- Management and staff will ensure any emergency exits remain free of obstruction.
- The premises will be operated according to its Fire Risk Assessment.

- Management and staff will encourage customers to leave the premises in an orderly manner.
