An Objection notice has been received from Sussex Police who believe that allowing the event to go ahead would undermine the licensing objectives:-

- the prevention of crime & disorder and
- the prevention of public nuisance..

This letter is a COUNTER NOTICE which prohibits the event from taking place.

As a result of the objection, a licensing hearing **MUST** be held to determine whether the event may proceed. The hearing will be held at Town Hall, Queens Road, Hastings, on Wednesday 03rd October 2012 at 3pm.

You are advised that a hearing may not be required, if all parties agree that it is unnecessary. This may occur if you as the applicant modify your application so that the concerns raised by the police are satisfactorily addressed.
