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Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

- 1) If this premises licence authorises the supply/sale of alcohol, the following two conditions apply:
 - (i) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
 - (ii) Every supply/sale of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence

- 2) If this premises licence authorises the exhibition of films the admission of children to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with this section.

Hastings Borough Council will expect the age restrictions of the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC) or authority designated under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 to be complied with. Only in exceptional cases will variations of this general rule be granted by the Council and then only with the appropriate safeguards

- 3) If this premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity (as defined by the Private Security Industry Act 2001) then such individuals must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

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Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

General

Close supervision with licence holder on premises most late hours.

The prevention of crime & disorder

To ensure the CCTV system installed, covering the takeaway area, is operational during trading hours and maintained.

To ensure the CCTV tapes / recorded images are stored and retained for 28 days and access is available to the police and licensing authority at reasonable times.

On 23rd December 2010 a consent order was granted by Hastings Magistrates Court, duly signed by both parties with the following conditions agreed by the premises licence holder:- On Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings a SIA registered door supervisor is employed between the hours of 12.00 (midnight) and 04.00 hours to limit the number of persons on the premises and to ensure that members of the public leave the premises in a quiet and orderly manner at the end of Licensable Hours. See Annex 3 – Consent Order.

Public safety

To comply with health & safety legislation.

To ensure the fire extinguishers are checked regularly and serviced annually.

To ensure the first aid kit is maintained and available for use.

The prevention of public nuisance

To ensure the refuse / waste is stored in a skip at the rear of the premises and collected twice weekly.

The proprietor shall provide & maintain suitable & sufficient litter bin(s) outside the premises during opening hours and shall, at the close of business each night, cause the street to be checked for and cleared of all litter that may have arisen as a consequence of the business. These measures may be undertaken in conjunction with the proprietors of other similar establishments in the vicinity.

On 23rd December 2010 a consent order was granted by Hastings Magistrates Court, duly signed by both parties with the following conditions agreed by the premises licence holder:- On Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings a SIA registered door supervisor is employed between the hours of 12.00 (midnight) and 04.00 hours to limit the number of persons on the premises and to ensure that members of the public leave the premises in a quiet and orderly manner at the end of Licensable Hours.

The protection of children from harm

We have listened carefully to all the submissions and we are bound to be directed by the promotion of the Licensing Objectives and Material Considerations of:

- **Prevention of Crime and Disorder**
- **Public Safety**
- **Prevention of Public Nuisance**
- **Protection of Children from Harm**

On balance, the Sub-Committee DOES NOT ACCEPT the evidence provided in support of the application and therefore the application fails to satisfy the principal material considerations.

We REFUSE the application for the following reasons:-

RESOLVED (unanimously) that the application be REFUSED for the following reasons:

The applicant has been unable to rebut the presumption that the granting of his application to vary the licence would undermine the licensing objectives. He has not demonstrated either on his operating schedule, nor in his submission this morning, that there would be no negative impact on one or more of the Licensing Objectives by allowing his application, in particular Crime and Disorder and Public Nuisance.


CONSENT ORDER




It is hereby Ordered that the following Condition be entered on the Premise Licence of the Premises known as Flames Grill, 19 Havelock Road, Hastings
