We hope that this application will be based on its individual merits and fully understand the potential concerns of this Kebab shop being based in a "saturation zone". We are sure that the Authority are keen to encourage small businesses in Hastings and we wish to point out that restaurants often do not cause the problems that other drinking establishments do. The advantage of people leaving drinking establishments late at night and attending Kebab shops for food and non alcoholic beverages are often too busy eating to be of nuisance.

From our point of view extending the opening hours by just one hour will reduce the serge of customers who gather just before closing time. This minor extension would stagger customers avoiding group gatherings and preventing the trouble that is often associated with these groups. Therefore the amenity quiet or good order of the locality in which the premises are situated would be upheld and could prove to have a positive impact in preventing crime and disorder and public nuisance. The staggering effect we hope to achieve will increase public safety with less people being in the vicinity at any one time. We therefore feel that this extension coincides with the Act's objectives of prevention of crime and disorder and increasing public safety.

This proposed variation of the Licence would be unlikely to result in undue offence, annoyance, disturbance or inconvenience to people who reside or work in the vicinity of the premises, and it would not cause disorderly conduct in the premises or in the neighbourhood.

The proposed extension will not prejudice the safety or welfare of any children as there is no school in the vicinity of the premises.

To further comply with the statutory objectives of the Licensing Act 2003 we propose to:

- 1. Employ security personnel to be at the premises for the extended one hour to ensure that no disorderly behaviour takes place on or around the premises and to move customers on once they have made their purchases;
- 2. Put up signs near the exits reminding customers that although not densely populated with residential premises we ask that noise be kept to a minimum;
- 3. Leave doors shut where possible, so that sound is controlled;
- 4. Ask taxi drivers to turn off their engines while they wait and to refrain from sounding their horns on arrival.

We ask that the Authority has regard to the above proposals and consider that we will be fully prepared to control the noise and behaviour of the number of persons that could be expected to be on and in the vicinity of our premises.

We feel that the varying of our licensing conditions does not undermine the licensing objectives and we do not see any likely health or social impact that granting the application would have on the population of the locality.
