


The premises has previously been operating under TENs applications, for those events held in 2013 with one exception they have not utilised opening hours as late as 4 am. Maximum numbers attending these TEN events has been stated as 310.

The principle of a licence for these premises has been established but at a level of impact consistent with the terms of the existing licence. It is my view that any new licence needs to be conditioned in a manner that ensures the aims of the saturation policy are met and that this application does not sufficiently demonstrate that given the wide ranging nature of the times and days asked for.
