Attendances at the main Museum and Art Gallery are still holding up well after the reopening last year. Visitor numbers to the Old Town Hall are slightly down on last year. This is also reflected in figures for the summer period for the Fishermen's Museum and Shipwreck and Coastal Heritage Centre.

The number of website hits continues to increase, and have more than trebled since first recorded in 2004.
