Background

1. Loan of Hawaiian Feather Cloak to Musee de Quai Branly

The cloak is now back in England following the damage it sustained in Paris. The Textile Conservator Alex Seth-Smith in Rolvenden is currently working on it, and it should be returned to the Museum in December.

All costs will be met by the Musee de Quai Branly.

2. Loan of Turner painting to Nottingham and Hull

'Hastings; Fishmarket on the Sands, Early Morning' by JMW Turner has now gone on loan as part of a Tate National Tour. It will be included in a large-scale exhibition entitled: 'Coasting; Turner and Bonington on the Shores of the Channel' and will be ondispaly at Nottingham castle until 15 February and the Ferens Art Gallery, Hull from 28th February to 3rd May.





The exhibition will then come to Hastings from 17th May to 31st August 2009.

Susan Faulkner, the Exhibitions officer, will be travelling to Nottingham to view the exhibition.
