# **Purpose of Report**

to provide an update on a suggested scheme for sponsorship of Museum objects

**Reasons for Recommendations** 

## **Background**

- A report to this Committee in March considered the suggestion of using a sponsorship scheme to fund-raise for the Museum. An amount of money could be paid for cleaning/conservation and the sponsor acknowledged on the label.
- Members considered that the word 'adoption' might be a better term to use, than 'sponsorship'.
- Legal Services were asked to look at the implications of such a scheme and report back.
- Their preliminary research has found that in theory such a scheme would be possible as Section 12(1) of the Public Libraries and Museums Act 1964 states that:
- 'A local authority may provide and maintain museums and art galleries within its administrative area or elsewhere in England and Wales, and may do all such things as may be necessary or expedient for or in connection with the provision or maintenance thereof.'
- The Museums Committee will now need to decide how it wishes to proceed, then Legal Services will be able to advise the Acting Curator further as necessary.
