Introduction

This report updates members on matters carried over from previous meetings and other items not included on the agenda.

1. Report on Curator's meeting with Cllr Webb

The Curator met with Cllr Webb at the Museum on 11 June 2010 to discuss priorities for the Museum service.

Following the departure of the previous Curator and subsequent changes in curatorial staffing levels, there will have to be a re-focusing of some of the Museum's activities. It was suggested that a site visit for members to look specifically at the core museum functions of collections management balanced with the priority of attracting visitors might be of interest. This visit could take place before or at the next Museums Committee meeting in September.

Other issues were raised during the discussion including storage of archaeological material, disposals to other museums and outstanding access issues in the Dinosaur Gallery.

The draft Museum Forward Plan 2010 - 2013 will be presented at the next Museums Committee meeting in September for comment.

3. Permission for film screening

Permission has been given to Electric Palace Cinema to screen films onto the window of the Old Town Hall Museum during Old Town Week on 5 August.

This is part of the Hidden Connections project, supported by Screen South which Beatrice Rapley, the Stade Education Officer, has been working on. The project is to bring archive film footage to public attention and part of the funding agreement is to hold public screening events, three of which have already taken place at the Bathing Pool site, the East Hill Lift opening and the WRVS Old Town Day.

Following the report to the last Committee, the issue of working with the Conservation Team and Environmental Services, to identify possible future funding opportunities, will be added to the Museum Forward Plan.
