4. Comment

Visits to both sites are down compared to the same quarter last year. December visitor numbers were particularly low, a reflection of the extreme weather conditions. Educational visits have also reduced in number; at Johns Place visits were made by EAC and CES Language Schools, University Centre Hastings, Sussex Coast College and St Mary's, Bexhill.

Schools started the academic year with uncertainties around their budgets and the impact on outside visits. The Education Officer visited Helenswood and Little Ridge,



and all the Museum Loan Boxes were fully booked for the duration of the first two terms.

Visits to the website have stayed level this year, but continue to show a drop on last year's figures.
