- 1. The plaque to Alan Turing was unveiled on the centenary of his birth on 23 June. There was coverage on BBC Radio Sussex and in the Hastings Observer.
- 2. The redisplayed Plains Indian Gallery was opened on 30 June by Cllr Westley. This project was funded by World Stories South-east, led by the Arts Council and LOCOG.
- 3. The 3D scan of the Durbar Hall made by the RPS Group was entered into an Innovations Award in July, but unfortunately did not win.
