Purpose of Report

to report on a request for the extension of the loan of the Turner watercolour

Reasons for Recommendations





Introduction

- 1. This item was not included on the Agenda as the request was received on 12 September 2012.
- 2. A response to the request is required by the organising institution, the National Maritime Museum, as soon as possible.
- 3. At the September 2011 Museum Committee it was agreed to approve the loan of the JMW Turner watercolour 'Hastings: Fishmarket on the Sands' to a major exhibition at the National Maritime Museum from November 2013 to March 2014. The exhibition, 'Turner and the Art of the Sea' will be a landmark reappraisal of the subject.
- 4. The National Maritime Museum has agreed a second venue for the exhibition, which will be moving to the Peabody Essex Museum, Salem from 4 June to 1 September 2014. The organisers are keen for as many of the works as possible to travel onto the second venue, and wish to include the Hastings Turner.
- 5. The Peabody Essex Museum in Salem, Massachusetts, is a major US museum with important collections of maritime and world art. Many of the collections date back to the parent foundation in 1799.
- 6. The Hastings Turner watercolour is currently resting in store and will be then going on display at Petworth from January to March 2013.
- 7. Hastings Museum and Art Gallery will put the Turner on display for 6-8 weeks in the summer of 2013, between the loan dates. It could then be shown again in 2015, after another few months of rest.
- 8. All insurance, packing, transportation, security and environmental conditions and costs will be covered by the receiving venues.
- 9. The 'Turner and the Art of the Sea' exhibition represents a major opportunity for the Hastings painting to reach a wide audience in prestigious venues. It is recommended that permission is given for the extension to the loan.
