Introduction

This report updates members on matters carried over from previous meetings and other items not included on the agenda.

- 1. The Museum's painting of the Fishmarket by J.M.W. Turner will be on display at the Museum from 13 July to 1 September, before going on loan to the National Maritime Museum and Peabody Museum, Salem.
- 2. A member of staff has been appointed under the Permeate Fellowship scheme, sponsored by Arts Council England. James Perry commences on 6 June and will work for 6 months as a Documentation Assistant.
- 3. Permission has been given for the use of the following images.
 - Two images relating to John Logie Baird and Linton Crescent to be used by ITV for their series on' Britain's Secret Homes'.
 - A drawing of 'The Conqueror's Stone' by Marianne Johnson for artists' project website www.tillwehavebuilt.com.
 - An Image of the Baird poster for 'Armchair Books' by Joe Moran.
 - An image of the Blue Saloon by E L Badham for family history book written by Small family.
 - Two images of Hastings for publication of a 19th century diary by Susan Macklin.
- 4. East Sussex Record Office is now closed until the autumn to allow the transfer of all archives to the new Keep at Falmer. Hastings Museum has a list of all accessioned items passed on from the Museum and HBC. The catalogue entries of 90% of ESRO's holdings are available electronically on the Access to Archives website, and all documents accessioned since 1979 are listed on the East Sussex website. The refurbished Hastings Library will have links to local documents in due course. Further discussion is to take place into the extent that copies of local documents can be made available in Hastings.
