### 3. DEVELOPING OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY

Graham Belchamber, Scrutiny and Democratic Services Manager, presented a report advising members of the views of the Audit Commission on the positive role and input of Overview and Scrutiny into the council's internal controls and performance management. The report also highlighted work commissioned by the Chairs and Vice Chairs of Overview and Scrutiny to further develop the function.

# 4. CORPORATE PLAN PART III – YEAR END PERFORMANCE DATA AND TARGET SETTING

Jane Hartnell, Head of Policy, Partnerships & Sustainability, presented the Corporate Plan Part III.

The report advised members of the year-end actual performance by staff in the Corporate Resources Directorate and the Personnel and Organisational Development Service against the targets and milestones set out in Part II of

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the Corporate Plan for 2008/09. It noted the areas of shortfall and the actions that will be taken to improve performance during 2009/10.

Members discussed the targets for Financial Services, Internal Audit and Investigations, Legal and Democratic Services, Information Technology, Policy and Performance and Personnel and Organisational Development (POD).

The committee discussed those targets which had been not been fully met over the last twelve months, especially those in the council tax collection and benefits areas. It was acknowledged that the department had been performing well until the last quarter, but the economic downturn was the probable cause of the fall in collection rates. Members thanked all staff in this department for their work.

Members also discussed risk management, training opportunities for women managers and health issues. It was suggested that members receive a briefing from the PCT or members of the Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee in order to gain more detailed information.
