9. REVIEW OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT AND THE NEW ETHICAL FRAMEWORK – THE GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

The Borough Solicitor submitted a report on the Government's proposals relating to standards in public life. The proposals provided for further localisation of the system, to give local authorities greater ownership of the system, with the Standards Board continuing to have a strong, strategic role in providing guidance and support, and promoting best practice on the handling of allegations of misconduct. The role of coopted independent members would be reinforced. The code would be made simpler and easier to understand and operate at a local level.
