8 ETHICAL GOVERNANCE TOOLKIT

The Borough Solicitor and Monitoring Officer reported that the Improvement and Development Agency (I&DeA), the Audit Commission and the Standards Board for England, had joined together to devise an Ethical Governance Toolkit. The purpose of the Toolkit was to assist authorities to assess and understand how well they were achieving under the ethical framework, what more needed to be done to improve their position and how to make this improvement sustainable. The report contained details of the toolkit and how it worked. Members' views were sought regarding use of the "light touch" exercise.

The Borough Solicitor and Monitoring Officer reported at the meeting that the likely financial cost of the Light Touch Health Check would be up to £5,000.

<u>RESOLVED</u> that consideration of participation in the Light Touch Health Check exercise be considered when the review of complaints is reported in six months time and in the meantime opinions be sought on the toolkit from Councils that had undertaken the process.
