





Connected Futures Hastings update for the Hastings Strategic Partnership Date: October 2022

Key messages and Progress

Project Funding and Duration:

- Funding overall £16 million allocated for phase 1 (7 projects) and phase 2 (6 projects)
- Project duration:
 - Phase 1 October '22 December '23
 - Phase 2 January '24 for 3 4 years (now to fund six of the seven projects)

Mobilisation:

- Core Partnership Hastings Borough Council, East Sussex County Council, CXK
 - Group driving project forward and meet millstones (monthly meetings until December then bi-monthly to ensure project success
 - Terms of Reference agreed and validated
 - Monthly reporting on progress
- Wider Reference Group (see project focus pdf)
 - Engagement of members occurring and planned meetings for November
 - o Terms of Reference draft and ready for review
- Young Persons Research Group (YPRG)
 - Project lead (currently CXK member of staff) vacancy is live
 - o Recruitment of Youth worker in place
 - Recruitment and selection of ten young people to start imminently
 - Young people will be trained & accredited for their research activity and will be reimbursed for their engagement for the duration
 - Young people will have representation on both Core Partnership and Reference Group

Project Management:

- CXK is lead and accountable organisation and responsible for the project on a day-to-day basis. Reports into the above 3 groups and steered through the Core Partnership and YPRG
- Using workstream project management and reporting by exception to Core Partnership and Youth Futures Foundation
- Engage closely with the current system change/mapping occurring in Hastings to share information, learning and practice







External Support:

- **Renaisi** Learning Partner. Provides the wrap around support and development of the three groups along with the focus of research to include
 - Theory of Change (needs)
 - Mapping of skills across the partnerships and supporting gaps
 - o Research Question/s, Hypothesis, lines of enquiry
 - o Development of the YPRG skills and needs, wider support of system change and researcher skills
- IPSOS MORI LMS and Mapping
 - How and in what ways partnerships are currently using Labour Market Information (LMI) to inform and support your work?
 - What would partnerships like to get out of the local labour market expectations? (i.e., types of outputs, key areas of interest)
 - \circ $\,$ Any opportunities / risks that they would like to highlight to us

Moving Forward:

- Introduce young people onto both the Core Partnership and Wider Reference Group to influence decision making and ensure young people inform the research projects direction of travel
- Article to be published communicating the messages of the project and outcomes. Aim to engage communities
- Local launch of project planned for 2022 in central Hastings with two further soft launches in surrounding wards (locations to be agreed) once young people are recruited
- Establish a base in Hastings for young people, communities, employers, and partners to meet and centralise activities
- Develop further relationships with the other six projects (particularly ones that share similar characteristics to Hastings focus [Blackpool] to learn and adopt best practice
- Formalise mapping of LMI and gaps to inform research focus
- Agree research focus and instruments to build the evidence base for the suggested system change
